Safe and Secure Policy Management: Industry-leading technologies, including RBACs, content moderation, controlled connections and language filters, ensure students' safety. Policies can be set for the whole district or allow customization at school or classroom levels. Administrators determine which users within the community can communicate with each other, and which users can "discover" or search for others to add as their connections.

Structured Community Groups: Designed from the bottom up to support the needs of administrators, educators, students and parents, enabling collaborative, authentic learning within structured district and school communities. Within each community is a hierarchy of online groups to facilitate communication and collaboration on classes, projects or subjects of interest, such as "Mr. Smith's 3rd Grade Class," "The Environmental Club," or "James Middle School PTA." Group owners – typically teachers or administrators – determine which Web 2.0 tools to include in the group and set the policies for the group members, including content moderation and permission to comment.

Integrated Access to the ePals Global Community™: If allowed by the district, school or teacher, users may have direct access to our community of 650,000 educators and millions of students across 200 countries and territories to safely connect, exchange ideas, and work together on collaborative projects, including those created by ePals & National Geographic.

Full Web 2.0 Suite: State-of-the-art user profiles, blogs, wikis, forums, media galleries, pages and RSS feeds are embedded into every group. Group owners determine which tools are surfaced in the group for their members' use.

Digital Lockers & Electronic Portfolios: Each user has an online storage area to store and share personal school files including documents, photos, video, and audio. Each file can be tagged as public for sharing, or private for editing.
